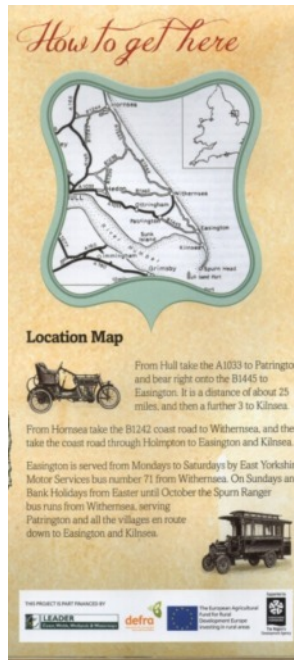
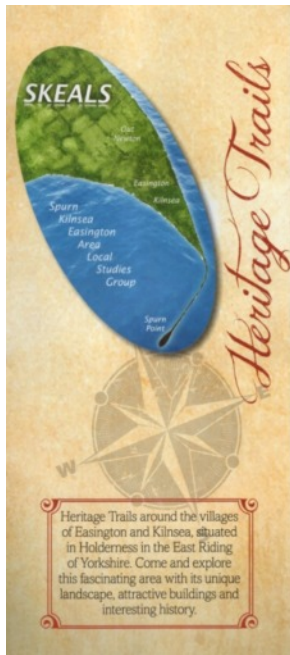


# SKEALS Heritage Trails

As announced previously, the Heritage Trails of Easington and Kilnsea was officially launched on April 14<sup>th</sup> 2012, in a ceremony in the village Community Hall. The two separate trails can be followed around each village with the use of a free map/leaflet as a guide, with some information on various aspects of the local history.

There are eight wooden numbered marker posts in each village; these correspond with places on the map, pointing out places of interest. In addition there is an information board prominently placed in each village, again giving some guidance as to direction and place locations.
